**Conditions:**

1. The school is registered under the Child Rights Education Act, 2009, and the Karnataka Education Act, 1983 and the rules framed there under, and the accreditation is renewed up to the registered class. Apart from these classes, additional classes and extra sections are not permitted.
2. The school shall function under the rules framed under the Karnataka Education Act 1983 and the Child Rights Education Act 2009.
3. Child Rights Education Act 2009 under the rules framed under it 25% seats are reserved for weaker section (RTE) children. [Government has made rules to facilitate the enrollment of children in neighboring schools where their parents live, according to which, if there are government and government-funded educational institutions, children will be enrolled in that school) Otherwise, private schools enroll children enrolled by the government and allow them to continue their education up to the primary level enabling these children to continue their education without any discrimination.

4. Government will release fees of children enrolled under RTE rules as per rules as described in **Kandike**. Hence it has stopped charging any fees from these children.
5. The school and the school management are prohibited from collecting any arbitrary capitation fee and voluntary donations from the parents either at the time of enrollment or thereafter.
6. The school/management board shall publish the information on the fees collected from the parents of the children in their school as tuition fees on the departmental website and on the school notice board as per the State Government Notification No.: ED:31 PGC 2017, Date:27.07.2019. No fee shall be collected in excess of the prescribed fee.
7. The School / Governing Body shall enroll the students within the period fixed by the Govt.
8. The School / Governing Body cannot refuse enrollment against the following points.
  - (i) Due to lack of proof of age.
  - (ii) On the basis of caste, religion, place of birth, language.
  - (iii) If entry is sought after an extended period of time in the area.
9. Carrying out all safety measures as per RTE Act and Rules, Karnataka Education Act and Rules. (Fire safety and building safety certificate from concerned authorities and child learning safety as per K.S.C.P.C.R and N.C.P.C.R).
10. School/Governing body for the following
  - (i) In any class till the completion of primary education and secondary education of any admitted child in the school not to be held back or expelled from school.
  - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical or mental abuse.
  - (iii) No child shall be required to pass any board examination till completion of primary education.
  - (iv) Every child who completes primary education is issued a certificate as prescribed under Rule 21 of RTE and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
  - (v) As per the provisions of the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules the school shall also admit children with special needs/special children.
  - (vi) Appointed teachers shall possess the minimum qualifications as prescribed for primary and high school teachers in the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and Government Orders.
  - (vii) Salary and allowances payable to teachers and terms and conditions of service shall be as prescribed by the State Government. And salaries are paid to teachers through government notification (Provident Fund (P)) and payable bank and other salaries and subject to Employee State Insurance (ESI).
  - (viii) Teachers shall perform the duties prescribed under Section 24[1] of the Act and the RTE Act and Rules and Rule 17 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and shall not engage themselves in private tuitions for supervisory considerations.
11. Adherence to the academic state curriculum and state text books to which the school is affiliated.

12. The school shall maintain rules and standards as specified in section 19 of the Karnataka Education Act, appoint departmental staff as prescribed in the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
13. School buildings and other basic facilities associated with the school should not be given over to any commercial activities or political and non-educational activities during the day or night.
14. The school shall not be run for the benefit of any person or group or association.
15. Get the school audited by a Chartered Accountant, copy of the same shall be given to the Deputy Director / Field Education Officer by the end of June every year.
16. School should follow according to Government notification [Kannada Bhasha Neeti 2016].
17. Governing body and teachers to act as per RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
18. The school / governing body shall strictly follow the rules and directives of the Government and the Department.
19. It mandatory to upload school information on S.T.S.C. as per rules by the end of March every year.
20. Violation of the above conditions will result in the cancellation of the recognition of the school as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
21. After the school accreditation process is completed, the entire document/information in the application submitted online by the governing body will be made available for public viewing on the departmental website.
22. Violation of the above conditions will result in the cancellation of the recognition of the school as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.

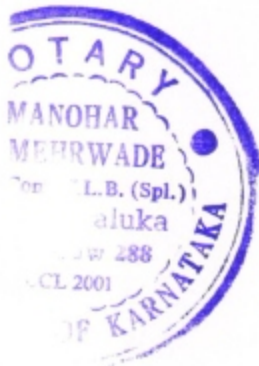
